

# Robert Stewart Memorial Scholarship Otsego High School

The Robert Stewart Memorial Scholarship encourages Otsego High School juniors and seniors to pursue math and science related degrees at top universities. The \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded at most once per year to either a junior who will spend the summer between their junior and senior year attending classes at either Cornell, Harvard, or Stanford; or to a graduating senior who will pursue a bachelors degree.

## Criteria:

- Must have attended Otsego High School for all grade levels currently offered.
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.75.
  
- Seniors must be pursuing a degree in a math or science related discipline.
- Seniors must have been accepted to a program leading to a bachelors degree.
- While there are no absolute requirements in terms of schools to which eligible seniors must apply, they are **encouraged** to apply to top math and science universities including, **but not limited to:**

Caltech, Cambridge, Carnegie Mellon, Colorado School of Mines, Columbia, Cornell, Dartmouth, Georgia Tech, Harvard, Johns Hopkins, MIT, Northwestern, Olin College, Princeton, Purdue, Stanford, University of California - Berkeley - Los Angeles - San Diego, University of Illinois - Urbana-Champaign, University of Pennsylvania, University of Texas - Austin, University of Washington, University of Wisconsin - Madison, Wellesley College

## Requirements

- One letter of recommendation from an Otsego High School math or science teacher.
- A second letter of recommendation from a non-family member.
- *Please speak with your recommenders ahead of time, and send their names and e-mail addresses along with the rest of your application. The Scholarship will contact them independently to obtain the recommendations.*
- Transcript of Otsego High School grades.
- A list of extracurricular activities, awards, scholarships, and special recognitions.
- One 2 – 3 page essay answering one of the following:
  - If you could have any job you wanted after college, what would it be and why?
  - What motivates you academically?
